

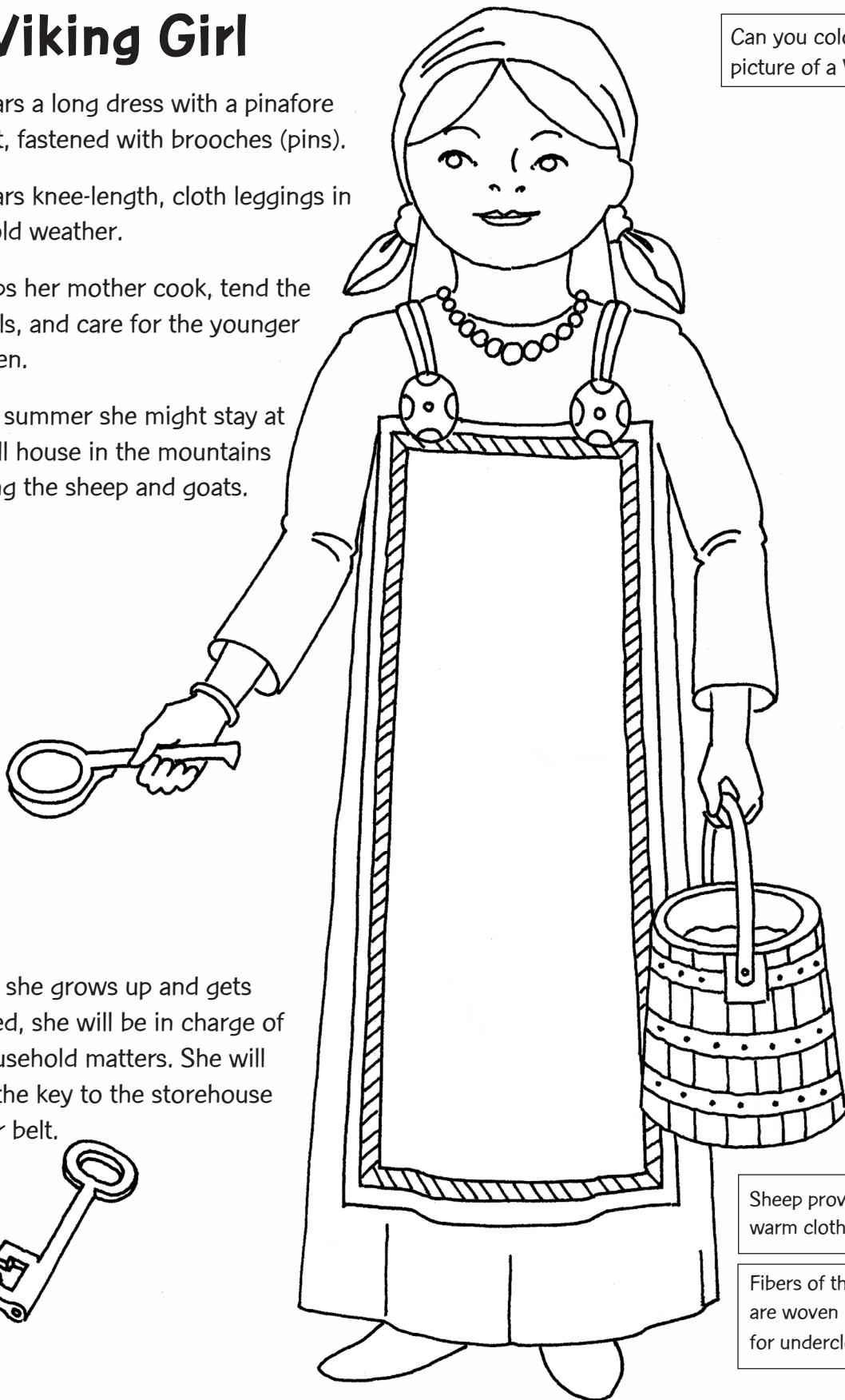
A Viking Girl

... wears knee-length, cloth leggings in the cold weather.

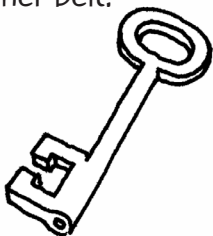
... helps her mother cook, tend the animals, and care for the younger children.
